




The Treasure Coast is a region of Florida on the state's Atlantic coast, comprising of Indian River, St. Lucie, and Martin counties. This area was given its nickname after a fleet of 11 treasure-carrying Spanish ships were sunk by a hurricane off the coast. To this day, these treasures can sometimes still be found washed up on the shores by lucky beachgoers.

Port St. Lucie occupies an area of 120 square miles in St. Lucie County on Florida's east coast, about 50 miles north of West Palm Beach, halfway between Miami and Orlando.
